WARNING CARD

Extract of General Regulations, Art. 174

In cases of offences mentioned in paragraphs 6.2 (abuse of horses) and 6.3 (incorrect behavior) above and which are of a less serious nature, the President of the Ground Jury or of the Appeal Committee and the Chief Steward, instead of the procedures foreseen in the legal system, may deliver to the Person Responsible a yellow warning card, either by hand or by any other suitable means. The acceptance of a warning card suspends any penalty until new offences take place.

The Person Responsible may or may not accept the warning card. If the PR does not accept a card which was delivered or presented during or after the event, the event officials may take any action within their capacities deemed necessary and shall report the case to the Secretary General for any further action deemed necessary. Should the same Person Responsible receive one more warning card at the same or any other international event within one year of the delivery of the first card, the case shall be submitted to the Judicial Committee.

Where a warning card has been accepted, the offence for which it was delivered shall be taken into consideration when deciding the penalty to be imposed for a similar offence committed within the next twenty-four months.
