- ❖ The **2010 “Hartpury College International Eventing Forum”** presents an important learning opportunity for Eventing riders, trainers, coaches, owners and supporters – at all levels.

- ❖ This will help to enhance riding, training and coaching skills.
- ❖ There will be an opportunity to hear the ‘latest’ information from the **FEI** and **British Eventing** Safety Committees.

1. Creating “Jump” Ownership

Eric Smiley FBHS will present on the responsibilities of horse and rider when jumping, with the emphasis on Cross Country.

2. Racing – a balanced approach

Training the partnership of horse and jockey – to jump at speed – will be demonstrated by Yogi Breisner FBHS, and some National Hunt jockeys.

3. Dressage – the relationship with Jumping

Pammy Hutton FBHS will dispel the ‘myth’ that the higher level of dressage can be detrimental to Jumping.

4. What can we learn from the Show Jumpers?

An insight into the training methods of jumpers will be given by Di Lampard [GBR] and Shane Breen [IRL].
