

**Proposals of Clarifications to be submitted to FEI Bureau and General Assembly 24-27 April 2002.**

The Eventing Committee, in the light of all the changes made to the rules last year, have readdressed the following issues and will make the following proposal of rule clarification to the FEI Bureau / General Assembly in April.

**2.1. Qualifications for CIC\*/CCI\*s:** Clarification of Art 507 Table of qualifications for CIC\* and CCI\* - replace current wording with “These competitions are open only to competitors and horses certified as qualified to compete by their NF. NFs must establish qualifying standards.”

**2.2. Exemptions requests for CICs in 2002:** Clarification, add under Art 507.15.2, “For CICs – under exceptional circumstances exemptions from CIC qualifying standards in 2002 will be considered providing the horses and riders fulfill the qualifying standards as per the CIC 2001 qualifying procedure printed in Bulletin 10/2000 page 51-52.”

**2.3. Deadline for Qualification of CIC:** Clarification, add under 507.5: “Upon request of the NF the FEI will accept that the deadline for qualification for CICs only be reduced exceptionally to 2 weeks before the events begins.”

**1.4. Falls in Jumping test** – Clarification, Article 542.1 – clarification to line up as per the Eventing Committee policy to follow the Jumping rules as far as practical. Please add “ For all Eventing CCIO’s, Championships and Games, the competitor will be eliminated after the second fall. The first fall will incur 8 penalties.”

For the 2003 Eventing Rules, the Eventing Committee is suggesting to apply this rule of rider elimination after the 2nd fall in the Jumping test for all International Eventing events. Therefore it will be proposed to the FEI Bureau in April to enforce this change immediately.
